Clay limestone hillsides in the middle of Fronsac country, west of Libourne 3 hectares 37

Vineyard

Merlot & Cabernet Sauvignon

Vinification

Hand harvest with sorting on feet and on table Natural fermentation with indigenous yeast Thermal regulation

Ageing

Barrels of 3, 4 wines and new barrels (light heat)

Patrick Dussert (Guide Dussert-Gerber 2020) Subtle and supple, long in the mouth with characteristic smoky nuances, with balanced tannins, still a little young but very promising.

Guide Hachette

Vanilla, mocha, so many notes coming from 12 months of aging in barrels. The woodiness is certainly present in the bouquet but the aromas of black fruits are also there. A supple and round body fills the palate and leaves a nice aromatic trail.
